SAILING - If you're on a skippered charter why not take advantage of having the knowledge and expertise of a Master Skipper at your beck and call. Learn 'the ropes' and leave your holiday with a new skill.

SNORKELING - The Palm Islands have some of the most pristine fringing reef on The Great Barrier Reef. Get up close and personal with the resident marine life - the experience will change your life.

FISHING - As this region is virtually untouched, there can be some spectacular fishing opportunities to take advantage of. Your skipper can take you to the best (and most secretly guarded) spots he knows so you could be eating fresh fish for dinner every night if you're keen.

BUSHWALKING - Getting off the boat and stretching your legs you will find a myriad of walking tracks on a number of the islands with spectacular lookouts and views to reward your efforts.

STARGAZING - You'll be in remote waters under bright star filled skies the majority of the time so get to know the Australian star system with the onboard telescope and star maps to guide you.

BIRDWATCHING - There are hundreds of species of tropical birdlife living, nesting and feeding off these wilderness islands. Why not take the boats binoculars and bird book and see how many you can record whilst on holiday.

WATERSPORTS - If you're a watersports enthusiast then a variety of activities can be partaken of whilst on charter. Everything from kayaking, sail boarding, jet skiing and diving are on offer to hire and enhance your holiday experience.

EXPLORATION - Go exploring on island time (Maggie style) and get to know the locals. There are many quirky characters and tall stories to be had if you hire a Moke, jump on an open air bus, stop for a latte or a frozen margarita or several. Immerse yourself in the incredible history of the region from the discovery of Magnetic Island to the part the coral coast played in the second world war. Take home memories of the 'sea country' you will be visiting by learning the islands indigenous names, the untold history and even a piece of native art.

SURVEYING & REPORTING - Alleviate some of your carbon footprint whilst on holiday by assisting The Great Barrier Reef Marine Park (GBRMPA) to monitor some of the reefs changes and disturbances.
